HOW TO MAKE A CUSTOMISED CONTACT PAGE IN LIGHTROOM CLASSIC

- Open up Lightroom and leave it in the Library with all your pictures showing in the Film Strip in the bottom tool bar.
 I would suggest to make it easer is to give the photo's you want to put on the Contact Sheet a Rating. Then when you do this they are the only ones to show in the Film Strip.
- 2: Now open up Print in the top right menu, and select Custom Package.
- 3: This will open a blank page in the print module. Now all you have to do is Drag and Drop your selected pictures onto this page and adjust the size and order of each Photo.
- 4: You can now if you want select the number of rows and columns you want on the sheet. You can also make a cell spacing.
- 5: Now click and drag each photo onto the Contact Sheet and arrange in the order you want them. When done you can either print the sheet or save it.
- 6: If you decide to save it open up the Print Job in the Right Hand Menu, and when open select JEPG. Now go down go to the bottom of the menu click on Print To File. This will open up an Export Box, complete the Save AS box and also send it to the Desk Top.
- 7: From the Desk Top you can send the Contact Sheet to Photoshop and add all the text information you require. When done save it and return it to the Desk Top.
- 8: Now from here you can return it back to Light Room and print it then save to a Folder or a Collection if you wish.
